Theatre performance based on the namesake piece written by an American play writer Israel Horovitz was put up in State Drama Theatre on Vassilievsky.

Mathias is considered a failure, but finally he has a stroke of luck - his father bequeathed him luxurious apartments in Paris. But things are not as simple as they seem at first sight - there already live two ladies, thanks to whom Mathias learns about a whole bunch of family secrets and problems.

The play was staged by a guest director - an American with Italian origins John Pepper. Despite the fact that the director does not speak the language, the story turned out very Russian - the eternal problem of generation gap, voluminous statements of the characters, memories of the past and unspoken, but quite predictable happiness in the end.

The play is worth visiting at least due to the starry cast. The main character is presented by Dmitry Vorobiev, who is called one of the best actors of the city by aisle-sitters, and the elderly owner of the apartment is played by Elena Rakhlenko.
